We write the conclusion to wrap up our story.

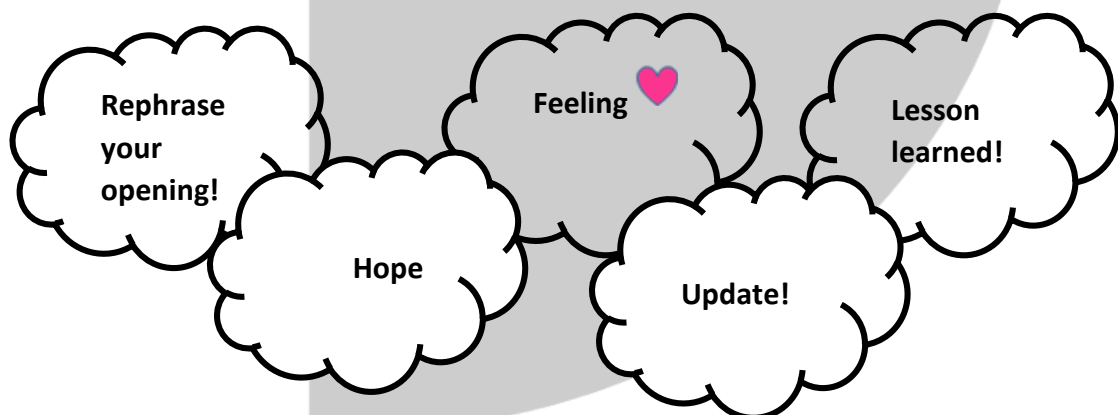
We also want to remind the reader of main idea of the narration.
